### MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: LG Android 5.0 Interim Security Configuration Guide (ISCG) Version 1

Reference: DoD Instruction 8500.01

DoD Instruction 8500.01 tasks DISA “develops and maintains control correlation identifiers (CCIs), security requirements guides (SRGs), security technical implementation guides (STIGs), and mobile code risk categories and usage guides that implement and are consistent with DoD cybersecurity policies, standards, architectures, security controls, and validation procedures, with the support of the NSA/CSS, using input from stakeholders” and DoD Component heads “ensure that all DoD IT under their purview complies with applicable STIGs, security configuration guides, and SRGs.”

DISA considered all the applicable technical NIST SP 800-53 requirements while developing this ISCG. Requirements that are applicable and configurable are included in this ISCG.

Under the authority of DoD Directive 8500.01, DISA is releasing an interim security guide for the LG G3 smartphone with the caveat that a container application must be used to provide data separation between personal data and DoD data. Component Authorizing Officials (AO) should be aware that the use of a container application adds additional risk when compared to a mobile device that provides data separation integrated into the operating system and be prepared to accept this risk prior to deploying the LG G3 device.

In accordance with DoD Instruction 8500.01, the LG Android 5.0 ISCG Version 1 is released for immediate use. The document is available on <http://iase.disa.mil>.
